Get Started, Get Organized, Don't Give Up.

Start your search ASAP. Go to the area where the dog was lost.	Ask everyone you see if they've seen your dog.	Maintain your sighting log. Record every detail. Let the caller describe the dog they saw. Decide if it's yours.
Post signs.	Hand out Flyers. Knock on doors. Post on bulletin boards around town.	Gather information for your contact list. Check in with them periodically.
Keep a picture of the dog handy.	Post a flyer in your car.	Change your voice mail greeting to speak directly to a caller reporting a sighting.
Place ads in newspapers.	Post on Internet web sites. Google "lost dog."	Bring a leash, yummy treats, extra flyers, pen, notebook, cell phone, flashlight, maps, photos with you.
Be careful, always let someone know where you go.	Always express confidence, you will find your dog.	Keep looking, don't be discouraged, someone has seen your dog.

After you find your dog... Big Celebration!

Visit your vet for a check up.	Notify your contact list that the dog is found.	Remove all Lost Posters & Flyers.
Remove ads in newspapers.	Remove Internet "lost" listings.	Change your voice mail greeting to dog "found" greeting.
Thank everyone who helped in your search.		
Take any preventative steps necessary to keep your dog from getting lost again.
